Dear School District:

Based on our religious beliefs, and the June 27, 2025 Supreme Court ruling *Mahmoud v. Taylor*, I am hereby immediately opting out my children _____ from all LGBTQ+ related texts, surveys, and curricula lessons in their public schools, regardless of when that material is to be presented during the school day or at any District sponsored events.

I am further exercising my right to opt out my children from mandatory preferred pronoun usage and shared-sex bathroom, locker room and field trip lodging policies and transgender sporting events that allow opposite gender in gender specific sports at their public schools, which are predicated on the district leadership's beliefs about gender identity that run contrary to our religion and are a violation of both constitutional and statutory law.

Further should my children exercise any non-birth gender pronoun or gender identity, as the parent and per my religious views, I demand that I be notified.

I further opt my children out of any library materials that promote LGBTQ+ including those that may be accessible for viewing without having to check them out.

Further, whereas the "Rainbow" flag has been associated with support of the LGBTQ+ briefs, I opt my children out of any event that forces them to be exposed to such to the exclusion of flags that represent other protected classes including religious flags or symbols.

To be clear even the ACLU, national office in 2023 recognized that said flag represented LGBTQ+: "*Gilbert Baker created the LGBTQ+ Rainbow Flag in San Francisco in 1978 to celebrate visibility and empower the LGBTQ+ liberation movement.*"

I also look forward to learning about your plan to notify us about any upcoming LGBTQ+ lessons, including those on gender identity, before they are taught to our children in their public schools.

In addition to those rights expressed in the US Constitution and "*Mahmoud*", I point out that the Nevada Constitution specifically states, "*That perfect toleration of religious sentiment shall be secured, and no inhabitant of said state shall ever be molested, in person or property, on account of his or her mode of religious worship.*" And

Sec. 24. Equality of rights. Equality of rights under the law shall not be denied or abridged by this State or any of its political subdivisions on account of race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity or expression, age, disability, ancestry or national origin.

Section 24 recognizes religious rights equal and not subordinate to any others and no school district or other governmental agency shall therefore abridge these rights.

“Sec: 4. Liberty of conscience. The free exercise and enjoyment of religious profession and worship without discrimination or preference shall forever be allowed in this State, ...”

We further point out that extensively under NRS 388 persons are protected based equally on,

“(a) The schools in this State provide a safe and respectful learning environment in which persons of differing beliefs, races, colors, national origins, ancestries, religions, gender identities or expressions, sexual orientations, physical or mental disabilities, sexes or any other distinguishing characteristics or backgrounds can realize their full academic and personal potential;...”

Thus, any policy or actions that minimize our religious rights in favor of any other is a violation. Further, any policy that promotes any ideology to the point that it segregates and isolates other children from an education is a violation.

Please confirm receipt of my request. My expectation is that my request be implemented immediately.
